Kleen hub lancerer Danmarks første kaffekop retur-system

Det er nu muligt at låne og returnere genbrugelige kaffekopper fra cafeer, nemt og simpelt takket være en smartphone app.

København - 15. Februar 2021 - I Danmark bliver der hvert år bortskaffet millioner af engangs kaffekopper, som forårsager CO2 udledning, skovrydning og overbelastning af affaldssystemer. Det skal der laves om på nu.

Ved brug af kleen hub appen kan kunder låne en genbrugelig kaffekop gratis, i op til 10 dage uden opkrævning af depositum. App'en sørger for at kaffekopperne kommer tilbage i cirkulation. Kunderne kan returnere kaffekopperne til enhver partner cafe, hvor de bliver rengjort inden videre distribution.

"Da vi lancerede vores retursystem til genbrugelige madbokse var der hurtigt stor etterspørgsel på en lignende løsning for kaffekopper. Det har vi lyttet til og vi er nu klar til at lancere." Siger Simone Favorito, medstifter af kleen hub. Lanceringen af servicen kommer til live på et vigtigt tidspunkt for miljøet. Det er ikke længere en bonus at have et grønnere og mere ansvarligt alternativ til emballage, det er et must-have. På baggrund af det opbygger kleen hub hurtigt popularitet blandt virksomhedsinnehavere og deres kunder.

Kleen hub's dobbelt isoleret kaffekop i rustfrit stål er fremstillet til at bevare temperaturen på kaffe og andre drikkevarer, uanset om det er varm eller kold. Alt imens den er stilren og nem at rengøre. Netop fordi koppen kan genanvendes hundredvis af gange, har den en betydelig lavere negativ indvirkning på miljøet sammenlignet med engangs kaffekopper.

Kleen hub skønner at i dets levetid, kan deres kaffekop spare op mod 58,7 kg CO₂e og samtidig betydeligt reducere antallet af engangs kopper der flyder i det offentlige rum.

En af de første til at se potentialet bag kleen hubs nye service er medstifter af Coffee Collective, Klaus Thomsen. Han siger: "Vi er stolte af at være den første lille kæde af kaffebarer til at integrere kleen hub, og især være de første der kan lede vejen for andre kaffebarer i København. Jo flere kaffebarer og cafés der deltager, jo mere bliver der gjort for miljøet."

Kleen hub lancerer deres kaffekop retursystem i Februar i København og vil snart være at finde i andre danske byer.

Kleen hub launches Denmark's first coffee cup return-system

Borrowing and returning coffee cups from cafes is now possible and easy thanks to a smartphone app.

Copenhagen - 15th February 2021 - Millions of single-use coffee cups are disposed of in Denmark every year, causing unnecessary Co2 emissions, deforestation, and pressure on the waste management system that could otherwise be avoided. But things are about to change.

Using the kleen hub app, consumers can borrow a reusable coffee cup for free for up to 10 days. The app tracks all transactions and avoids any deposits while ensuring that the coffee cups will come back in the loop. Customers can return the coffee cups to any partner cafe where they will be sanitized and brought back into circulation.

"When we launched our return-system for reusable food containers we got a lot of people and cafe owners asking us to do the same with coffee cups. We listened, and we are now ready to launch." - says Simone Favorito, co-founder of kleen hub. The service is launching at a crucial moment for the environment when the demand for greener and more responsible packaging is not an extra, but a must-have. This explains why Kleen hub is rapidly gaining popularity among business owners and customers.

The kleen hub stainless steel coffee cup is designed to keep coffee and other beverages warm or cold while being stylish and easy to wash. Because it can be reused hundreds of times, it has a much lower environmental impact, compared to single-use coffee cups. The company estimates that in its lifetime a kleen hub coffee cup can save up to 58,7 kg of CO2e while reducing the amount of waste created by disposable single-use.

One of the first to see the potential behind kleen hub's new service is Klaus Thomsen, Co-Founder of Coffee Collective. He says: "We are proud to be the first small chain of coffee shops to roll this out, and especially to be a first-mover that can lead the path for other coffee shops in Copenhagen to follow. The more coffee shops and cafés that join, the bigger the impact for the environment."

Kleen hub has launched its coffee cup return-system in February in Copenhagen and will soon expand to other Danish cities.
